

SE Kindred Street / SE Johnson Avenue Transportation Improvements

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PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Improvements include 3,200 linear feet of 8' wide sidewalk and re-construction of ADA improvements at all roads and driveway tie-ins, bike lanes, on-street parking, streetscape improvements, pedestrian lighting, traffic calming bulb outs, pedestrian crosswalks, and pedestrian park access. Currently the street has limited sidewalks with no connectivity. These improvements will provide seamless connectivity between Downtown Stuart, the U.S. Post Office, Bruner Park and U.S. 1. The bike lanes and sidewalks will promote alternative modes of transportation. The project is partially funded by the City of Stuart CRA.

SE Kindred Street / SE Johnson Avenue Watermain Improvements

WATERMAIN REPLACEMENT

- *City to replace the existing 4" asbestos cement pipe with a new 6" HDPE watermain. The new watermain will be installed by directional bore, which is a trenchless method of installing underground pipe and has a minimal impact to adjacent property owners.*
- *Project is currently under design.*
- *Construction anticipated later this year.*
- *Approximate Construction Cost = \$100,000.00*
