

Call to **ARTISTS**



Public Works of Art

The City of Stuart's Sanitation Division is embarking on a public art project for its sanitation service fleet. We are soliciting artists to submit designs to be showcased as mobile murals on sanitation trucks. We envision these traveling murals will display the vibrancy of the City of Stuart, inspiring pride and reflecting the collaboration between our sanitation team and community in sustaining clean, beautiful spaces and places.

Artists are asked to create pieces that feature Stuart's prominent or historic landmarks, or illustrate the recycling paradigm of "reduce, reuse, recycle." Each artist will first submit a rendering of their mural concept along with an application to the art selection committee no later than August 19, 2022. Upon receiving design approval, the artist would create an 18" x 36" sized canvas artwork and deliver it to the Utilities & Engineering Department by September 30, 2022, to qualify for a \$500 stipend. A maximum of ten stipends will be awarded with a limit of one per artist.

At the committee's discretion, select designs will be transferred to a reflective, wash-resistant wrap for application to the sanitation vehicles in late 2022. On November 15, 2022, also known as America Recycles Day, a public announcement will be made to identify the artists and reveal the murals.

- The City of Stuart will retain ownership of the prints and will retain copyright on all the designs that are produced into mobile murals.
- If the design changes radically from the approved rendering, the artist may not receive the honorarium, and the submission likely will not be considered for this initiative.
- These sketches will be reviewed for suitability and diversity. Submissions that are sexually explicit or promote a particular product, logo, religious icon, or political ideology will not be considered for this program.
- Photographs do not qualify for this program.
- An Artist may have multiple entries but can only qualify to receive one \$500 stipend. An application and rendering must be submitted for each entry.

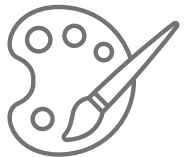

Describe your vision for the mural. Please do your best to describe in detail what the mural will look like and the visual style you will employ. Also, tell us what you hope viewers will get from your mural. How will it inspire, delight, connect, or celebrate our community and environment?

- The finished mural width measures almost twice its height. With this in mind, each artist should submit designs that would scale up to the desired mural wrap size.
- Artists will be notified as soon as possible when the submitted rendering is reviewed and approved so that canvas artwork can commence.
