

## “Hey, it’s me, Sammy Sailfish! Can we talk?”

**This is a friendly reminder that trash and recycle carts are remaining too long at curbside.**



In order to minimize the dangers of obstructed sight distances for drivers, roll your cart out for collection no earlier than 3:00pm on the day *preceding* collection and no later than 6:00am on the day *of* collection. The cart should face the street (handles on the sidewalk side) for automated collection.

For all residences, **remove your carts within 12 hours of collection.** Store your carts inside the garage or behind a fence, hedge, or areas screened from the street view as a courtesy to your neighbors. If these areas are unavailable, roll the cart to the side of the garage or house or to a point not less than 15 feet from the edge of the road.

In the coming month, I have asked my friends at Code Compliance to help me remind you of these cart practices. You may see these officers in your neighborhood.”
